If you use an EMR, how do you keep your knowledge current with its capabilities, updates, or enhancements?

(E.g.: online tutorials, peers, classroom training)

1) I am learning from peers.

2) We have Practice Partner. They have annual training sessions and updates if we want to send employees.

3) We get regular Epic updates as well as classroom training. In our office, we have HUG (Helpful User Group) meetings, usually once a month or so, for the providers to go over pearls that we have discovered with each other.

4) My vendor provides PDF versions of user manuals, videos, teleconferences and conferences to learn how to use features as updates are added. I also ask my peers and trial and error.

5) I don't have time to go over EMR updates. Some of my staff will go for training, but the problem is the hospital does not pay them a higher salary (based on higher training); it will only be a matter of time before the staff leave because of their salary and because they now have advanced training.

6) Conferences, trainers, super user groups, and shared best practices among 150 providers using ECW in and around Norman.

7) Peers.

8) On-line tutorials, CD the software company sends, and peers.
