Do you ever participate in volunteer work as a clinician? If yes, where?

- 1. Yes, at the Rogers County Free Medical Clinic, twice a month. And I serve on the board and as medical director.
- 2. At this time I do no volunteer
- 3. I volunteer once a month or so (although did not for the last year as I was out of town but am looking forward to resuming) at a free clinic run and organized at the Rogers County Health Department by one of our OKPRN members. She has been the tireless organizer of this clinic and it is a real service to the patients of Rogers County and surrounding areas. It's a real joy and privilege to work with her and the other docs and nurses who volunteer, and to be of some service in a small way to the patients.
- 4. Lighthouse Medical Clinic in South OKC
- 5. Broken Arrow Neighbors free clinic (usually first Monday of each month)
- 6. Little Flower clinic
- 7. City Rescue Mission clinic
- 8. I volunteer my time at an advocacy center for child abuse doing exams. Also doing sports physicals at area schools.
- 9. I volunteer Enid Community Clinic 8 3 hour shift per year
- 10. Enid High School 2 3 hour sports exams per year
- 11. Boy Scout physicals 1 4 hours camp exams twice a year
- 12. Northern Oklahoma College 3 3 hour shift g year
- 13. Yes, but not formally. If I talk to support groups, I listen to their stories and provide clinical input. If I get asked questions wherever I am and with whomever, I provide clinical input. I see neighbors and relatives of friends on request. I do not order tests or prescribe medications in these circumstances, but I often make recommendations for tests and medication changes. I always tell them they have to discuss with their PCP.
